Sir/Madam,

With reference to your complaint dated 02/06/2003, I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 10/01/2005. The Commission has made the following directions.

These proceedings shall be read in continuation of the earlier proceedings of the Commission dated 21.7.2004 and 15.9.2004.

Pursuant to the recommendations of the Commission dated 15 September, 2004, the Government of Tripura vide their letter dated 19.11.2004 has reported that in addition to the sum of Rs.15,000/- paid to the victim earlier, a further amount of Rs.35,000/- had also been paid to her, as per the recommendations of the Commission. Thus, it is stated that the recommendation of the Commission to pay an amount of Rs.50,000/- has been complied with.

It has also been reported that a criminal case is pending trial and the delinquent police officials have also been discharged from service w.e.f. 3.6.2003.

The reports are taken on record and the case is closed.
