Sir/Madam,

With reference to your complaint dated 23/12/2004, I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 12/03/2010. The Commission has made the following directions.

These proceedings shall be read in continuation with the earlier proceedings.


The Commission received a complaint dated 23/12/04 from Suhas Chakma of an NGO who had referred to an incident on 15/12/04 alleging indiscriminate firing by the State Security Personnel, injuring seven people, including some school teachers.

Vide proceedings dated 1/5/09 the Commission considered the material placed on record and called upon the S.P. Thoubal, Manipur to submit a further report to the Commission about the financial assistance given to the seven injured persons as well as the status of action being taken against the personnel of the CDO. As there was no response, the Commission vide proceedings dated 15/10/09 issued conditional summons for submission of the requisite report.

Pursuant to the directions dated 15/10/09 the Commission has received a report on 26/11/09 from SP Thoubal District, Manipur which reveals that the financial assistance of Rs. 10,000/- each to all the 7 (seven) injured persons were sanctioned on 4/1/05 and disbursed. The District Police had also contributed Rs 1,50,000/- as financial help to the injured persons. It is submitted that no departmental action was recommended apart from the suspension of one constable of Civil Police and three Riflemen of 3rd IRB. The report further submits that regarding the alleged incident an enquiry was conducted and SP Thoubal had taken steps to avoid such incidents.

The Commission has considered the material placed on record. The District Police contributed Rs. 1,50,000/- as financial help to the injured persons. Financial assistance of Rs. 10,000/- each, to all the 7 (seven) injured persons were sanctioned on 4/1/05 and the same was received by them. The Commission has not received any further complaint or communication from the complainant since 23/12/04 or from the injured persons after receipt of the financial assistance. In view of the aforesaid circumstances, no further intervention by the Commission is required. The case is closed.
