"Vide its proceedings dated 21st February, 2013, the Commission issued notice to the Government of UP to show-cause why it should not recommend monetary relief to the NOK of late Brajesh who died in police custody.

Thereafter, vide the subsequent proceedings dated 10.7.2013 recommended payment of Rs.5.00 lakhs as monetary relief to the NOK of the deceased.

A communication has been received from the Under Secretary, Home (HR) Department Government of Uttar Pradesh enclosing therewith the compliance report as well as the proof of payment of Rs.5.00 lakhs to the father and mother of the deceased Brajesh Yadav.

Since the recommendation of the Commission has been complied with, the case is closed."
