Sir/Madam,

With reference to your complaint dated 24/07/2013, I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 06/05/2014. The Commission has made the following directions.

The Commission received a complaint dated 24.07.2013 from Shri Amal Kanti Chakma, Complaints Coordinator, Asian Centre for Human Rights, in which it is stated that in the night of 14.07.2013 a group of 10-15 armed miscreants raided the Girl's Hostel at Lawada Village in Pakur District of Jharkhand. They abducted the four victims and gang-raped them. Vide its proceedings dated 01.08.2013, the Commission called for a report from the concerned authorities.

Pursuant to the directions of the Commission, the SP, Pakur, has submitted his report dated 27.09.2013, in which it is stated that the matter got inquired into through the Sub-Divisional Police Officer, Pakur. His report is annexed with, in which it is mentioned that a case Crime No. 64/13 was registered U/S 376 (d)/147/148/149/452/456 IPC and U/S 4/8 of Protection of Children Against Sexual Offences Act, 2012. The victims were medically examined and their statements U/S 164 Cr.P.C. were recorded. After completion of investigation a chargesheet No. 63/13 has been submitted on 19.09.2013 against all the accused persons showing accused Prabhudhan Hansda as absconder. It is further mentioned that as per the orders of the Deputy Commissioner, Pakur, Rs.60,00/- each has been paid to the victims and at present they have been admitted in Gandhi Residential Girls School, Pakur.

The Commission has perused and considered the report. It is clear from the report of the SP that chargesheet has been filed in the matter. The matter is sub-judice. Hence, no further intervention of the Commission in the matter is required. The SSP and District Magistrate, Pakur, are directed to arrange for proper counseling of the four victims. With these directions the case is closed.
