These proceedings shall be read in continuation of earlier proceedings of the Commission dated 06.05.2014 vide which a reminder was directed to be issued to the Chief Secretary, Government of Maharashtra, for submission of compliance report alongwith proof of payment.

Pursuant to the directions of the Commission, a communication dated 12.06.2014 has been received from the Section Officer to the Government of Maharashtra, Home Department, Mumbai, through which the proof of payment has been forwarded.

The Commission has perused and considered the report. As recommended compensation has been paid to the victim Mohd. Azhar, no further intervention of the Commission in the matter is required and the case is closed.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 30/01/2012 and the Commission has directed as follows.

After having found that Ms. Parveen Akhtar Shekih and her brother Mohd. Azhar were illegally detained at Police Station Shil Daigarh from 13.30 hours to 16.40 hours on 22.10.2010, the Commission ordered issuance of a show cause notice to the Government of Maharashtra, through its Chief Secretary, vide proceedings dated 08.08.2011. Ms. Parveen Akhtar Sheikh has since died.

No response to the show cause notice dated 11.08.2011 was received and, hence, a reminder dated 05/11.11.2011 was issued to the Chief Secretary concerned with the stipulation that in case no response was received, it would be presumed that the State had nothing to say in the matter and the Commission would proceed to pass an appropriate order. However, no response has been received from the Chief Secretary till date. Hence, it is presumed that the State Government has nothing to say on the show cause notice.


For the reasons detailed in its proceedings dated 08.08.2011, the Commission recommends to the Government of Maharashtra, through its Chief Secretary, to pay compensation of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand only) to the victim Mohd. Azhar. The Chief Secretary is directed to submit compliance report alongwith proof of payment within six weeks.

It is therefore, requested that the compliance report in the matter be sent to the Commission latest by 20/03/2012, so that the same could be placed before the Commission.
