Sir/Madam,

With reference to your complaint dated 19/09/2005, I am directed to say that the matter was considered by the Commission on 24/05/2006. The Commission has made the following directions.

*The Director, Asian Centre for Human Rights brought to the notice of the Commission that on 11.9.2005, the upper class people took one Ram Sevak, a Dalit. The assailants brutally beat up the victim with lathis and boots and spit on his face. The accused also forcibly shaved off his head, mustache and eyebrows and paraded him while beating him with shoes and spitting on his face. On complaint to the CO, the police instantly arrested the assailants, who accused him of making pistol and small fire arms.*

*He request to direct the State of Uttar Pradesh to order an judicial inquiry into the reported looting, torture, inhuman treatment to dalits, namely, Ram Sevak and others and to direct the State Government to arrest the accused and victims be suitably compensated / protected.*

*Pursuant to the directions of the Commission dated 6.10.2005, the SSP, Kanpur (Nagar) vide communication dated 12.12.2005 has sent a copy of the report dated 7.12.2005 received from CO, Ghatampur, Kanpur (Nagar). The report discloses that after going through police record and the statements, it came to light that Ram Sevak got registered a Crime Case No. 356/2005 u/s 147/323/504/506/500 IPC against Ghirpal, Manoj and others on 15.2.2005. During the course of investigation, accused Jagdish was arrested on 18.9.2005 and was sent to jail. The accused Manoj and other accused Ram Balak surrendered before the Court on 26.9.2005 and were sent to jail. In the course of investigation, the names of accused Sunil and Sabadin were found to be wrong and no offence u/s 147 IPC was found to be committed. After in-depth investigation, the police have filed a chargesheet No.191 dated 8.10.2005 against the accused Ghirpal, Manoj, Jagdish and Ram Salak before the Court. The other allegations made in the complaint could not be substantiated.*

*As the matter is now sub-judice, no further action by the Commission is called for.*
